# Reading tips

- Use the pictures
- Re-read a sentence if your child stops to work out words
- Comprehension-encourage your child to think about the sentence they read
- Good sight vocabulary including tricky words (Words that can not be sounded out e.g. are and was)
- Apply phonic skills

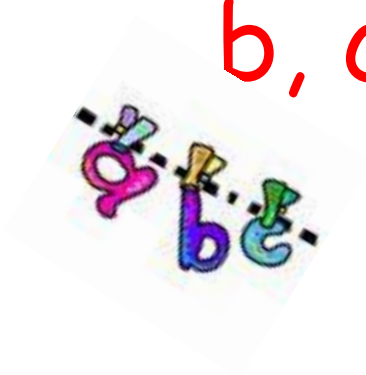

# Assessment

- **Key Learning Indicators of Performance**  
We follow a framework called KLIPs
- KLIPS is based on age related expectations for year groups
- These help us judge whether your child is **IN LINE** or **WORKING TOWARDS** aged related expectation

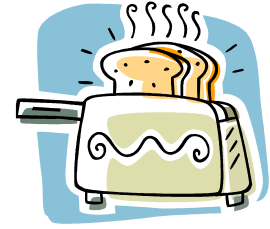
