EARLY LEARNING GOALS



- ▶ There are 17 Early Learning Goals that your child will work towards reaching by the end of EYFS.
- ▶ The majority of children enter Reception at the 30-50 months or 40-60 months age bands.
- ▶ The Early Learning Goal can only be reaching at the end of the 40-60 month band and will be given a grading of either emerging, expected or exceeding at the end of the year.
- ▶ Your child will be assessed informally continuously over the year through the use of Learning Journeys and the EYFS Development Matters.

HOME/SCHOOL PARTNERSHIP



We really value your contributions as parents and welcome your input into your child's learning. It is essential that we work together!

Enclosed in your Induction Pack are an *All About Me* booklet. They will help us to build up a picture of how your child is at home, as well as in school.

We also share information with parents through the Reading Record book, so if you need to tell us something and can't pop in, we do read these twice weekly and will respond as quickly as we can.

STARTING SCHOOL



- ✓ Starting school can be an exhausting business!
- ✓ Don't be surprised if your children come home feeling tired and not wanting to talk about their day.
- ✓ Give them a meal, a bath, a cuddle and a story, before getting them off to bed early.

WHAT CAN YOU DO TO HELP YOUR CHILD'S LEARNING BEFORE THEY BEGIN SCHOOL?



- Help your child to do the following independently
- To dress and undress
- To remove their coats, gloves and hats and hang them up
- To put shoes on and take them off
- To recognise and look after their belongings
- To use the toilet on their own
- To wash and dry their hands
- To use a knife and fork
- To tidy up
- To use a tissue
- To share and co-operate with other children

WHAT CAN YOU DO TO HELP YOUR CHILD'S LEARNING WHEN THEY BEGIN SCHOOL?



- ✓ Sharing books, talking about the pictures
- ✓ Reading Book, make comments in their home – school communication diary
- ✓ Ongoing-encourage mark making, shopping lists etc.
- ✓ Encourage children to talk
- ✓ Practise counting at any time-climbing the stairs, shopping etc
- ✓ Play simple board games
- ✓ Sing number rhymes and songs together
- ✓ Support any 'homework' that comes home; sounds and number work
- ✓ Sleep!



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
