

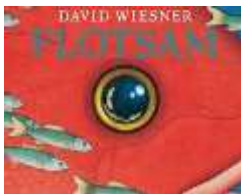
Through the Decades!

Every day, the children will get to choose a story they would like to listen to. Different adults will be reading different books to suit all interests.



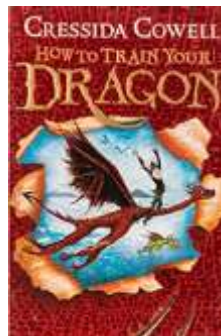
Food Fit for a Queen

This year, the older children will partner up with a younger child to become Reading Buddies. They will share stories with their buddy throughout the week.

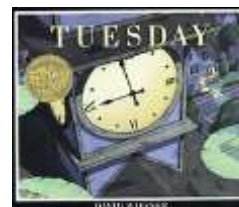


Lancaster Lane Book Week 2022 Reading Through the Decades!
