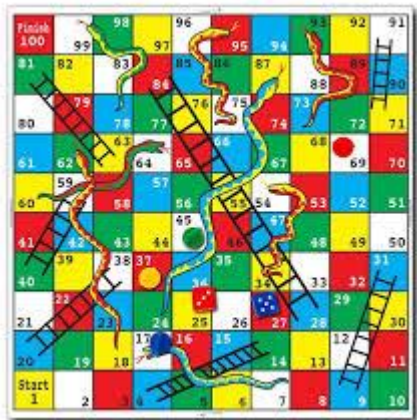


Year 1 Topic Work - Summer 2

Play board games

Talk about the UK

Talk about places you have and will visit in the UK.

Look at a UK map together to examine journeys you will make. Google Earth and Maps is a great app to explore. Try using 'street view.'

Identify countries, capital cities, and features on maps.

Print out and cut up a map of the UK for your children to try and stick back together. Use the one attached.



If you visit somewhere, draw and write a postcard that you can send to everyone in class. Think about what type of place it is; a beach location or a town.

Learn about beach safety

Talk about staying safe at the beach and in the sun.

Make a poster to share in school. This one reminds us to cover up and use sun cream!



Research on the internet.

Work with a grown-up to search for something on the internet.

Look for other countries on Google Earth, search for counting songs on You Tube, or use a child friendly search engine to find out about something that interests you.
