With the dinosaur bones you made (see above), try burying them in the garden and become a palaeontologist. Can you recover your bones so carefully that you don't break them?

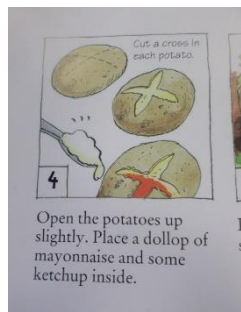
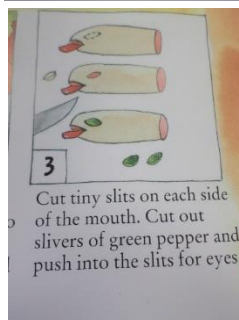
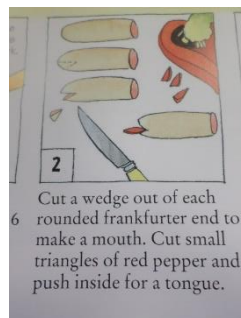
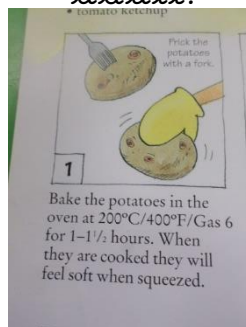


DRAW
