*Fortnite* is extremely popular at the moment but we want to ensure that IF you have given your child permission to play it (PEGI rating age 12+) that you are also aware of the potential dangers of such games and what you can do to help them themselves stay safe.



**Fortnite** is available on Xbox One, PS4, PC, Mac, iOS and Android is an online multi player game that has become a worldwide phenomenon since it launched a free 'Battle Royale' mode that allows up to 100 players fight it out 'Hunger Games' style until there's just one person left. The NSPCC and O2 have launched new advice for parents amid concerns over the game function that automatically allows users to speak to other players through voice and text chat functions. It means children can be contacted by anyone else who is playing the game. Users can disable voice chat in the game via the settings menu, but the text chat function cannot be turned off.
