### Online Safety Tip: Sharenting – What are the dangers of sharenting?

Identifiable images - For example, posting images of your child in school uniform, using their full name or showing them in recognisable places in your hometown can make it easy to locate your child. Linking your photos with your profile, information from updates you post, or your 'check-ins' can reveal a lot about your family's identity and habits. Once a picture is online, it can be tough to control where it can be seen and how it is used – despite being careful with your own privacy settings.
