Online Safety Tip: This month's featured app – Musical.ly

What age is Musical.ly recommended for?

Because of Musical.ly's emphasis on popular music, many videos include swearing and sexual lyrics, so it may not be age-appropriate for children to use on their own. It's also easy to find people wearing revealing clothing and dancing suggestively, although Musical.ly won't let you search for objectionable content such as "sex" or "porn." If you supervise your children and stick to songs you already know from the radio, Musical.ly can be a child-friendly experience. Commonsense.org recommends the app for age 16+ mainly due to the privacy issues and mature content. Musical.ly requires that users be at least 13 years old to use the app and that anyone under the age of 18 must have approval of a parent or guardian – although there are plenty of young tween musers. If your child wants to use the app, the account should belong to an adult who can monitor what younger users are browsing and sharing. Information from commonsense.org
