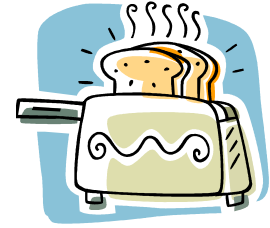

Key Literacy Skills

- A good sight vocabulary including tricky words (Words that can not be sounded out e.g. are and was)
- Apply phonic skills
- Comprehension
 - encourage your child to think about the sentence read
- Cursive letter formation

Expectations

- The expectations have been **INCREASED** since the new National curriculum was introduced in 2014
- All years groups (Y1 - Y6) now following the new curriculum

Assesement

- We follow a framework called KLIPs
(Key Learning Indicators of Performance)
- KLIPS is based on age related expectations for year groups
- This is different to the national expectations we used previously (pre 2014)
- These help us judge whether your child is **IN LINE** or **WORKING TOWARDS** aged related expectation

KLIPS

Key Learning Indicators of Performance

- A copy in all writing and maths books
- Achievement in reading will also be recorded using KLIPS
- Parents' Evening - KLIPS progress will be shared
