First agenda: Behaviour policy.	<p>Mr Clucas joined our meeting today to tell the School Councillors about changes to our Behaviour policy in school. Mr Clucas informed us that children can still earn Team Points and Dojos, but team points will be awarded for achievements and acts of kindness that impact on the wider school environment to celebrate children working together. Dojos will be awarded for individual achievements such as a good piece of work or answering a question well.</p> <p>Special Mentions will also continue, but children who receive a Special Mention will also be able to sit on the 'Top Table' at lunchtime with a friend of their choice. This will be on the Monday after receiving the Special Mention.</p> <p>Golden time will also continue every week to celebrate the children's excellent behaviour all week. However, if work is not completed in lesson or not to the best of your ability, Golden Times and break times can be used to finish incomplete work.</p> <p>The School Councillors were very excited about the new 'Top Table.'</p>
Second agenda: Children in Need.	<p>Mrs Welsh had spoken to Mrs Yardley and she had suggested we ask for donations of cakes and biscuits the week of Children in Need, and they could be decorated by some classes to be sold at the cake Sale on Friday 15th November. The School Councillors thought this was a wonderful idea. Haroon and Ollie suggested we could design posters to advertise the cake sale.</p> <p>The School Councillors reported back that their classes liked the idea of coming to school in odd clothes but weren't sure what this could include. We discussed this and Isabelle suggested we could come to school in brightly coloured clothes or colours that don't match, Haroon suggested mixing pyjamas and ordinary clothes, Harry suggested odd socks and Shea suggested shorts and jumpers. The School councillors thought this was a good idea and would discuss this with their classes.</p>
Would anyone like to mention anything else?	<p>Harry asked if we could have more sand in the sandpit.</p> <p>Isabelle asked if we could encourage children to only use the necessary amount of paper towels and toilet rolls because when she has been using the girls' toilets, there has been paper towels and toilet roll on the floor and it looks messy and is wasting paper. The School Councillors said they would take this back to their classes and remind children, Ollie suggested that if everybody picked up any paper towels around the sink areas, our school would look tidier.</p>
