School Council Meeting Agenda/Minutes.

Date: 29.11.2019	Classes present: Year 1: Tilly and Teddy, Year 2: Jack and Sienna, Year 3: Ruby and Max, Year 4: Isabelle (Harry not in school), Year 6: Haroon, Ollie and Shea.
Is anyone not able to attend?	Year 5 swimming.
First agenda: Agendas	Haroon and Ollie collected the agendas from the Year 5 and Reception classes. Early Learners had not had chance to add anything to theirs. There was a little confusion about which members of the School Council should collect them, so we confirmed that Haroon and Ollie as Chair and Vice Chair would collect the agendas from the classes which are unable to attend the meetings; Year 5, Reception and Early Learners. The School Councillors would be responsible for bringing their own agendas to each meeting. The School Councillors agreed that they would continue to remind their classes to write their ideas/suggestions/concerns on their class agenda and Mrs Welsh said she would mention this to the teachers.
Second agenda: Children in Need	I informed the School Councillors that we raised over £283 for Children in Need, combining the totals raised from 'odd clothes' and the cake sale. The School Councillors said they had enjoyed the theme this year and would inform their classes of the total amount raised.
Third agenda: Bins	Several classes have suggested that they would prefer bins on the playground and the Year 5 class suggested having a recycling bin on the playground as well. The School Councillors agreed that this was a good idea.
Fourth agenda: Christmas Jumper Day	We looked at the fundraising pack for Christmas Jumper day which will be held on Friday 13 th December. Similarly to last year, the School Councillors suggested children could come to school with any jumper and decorate it in class to avoid them having to buy a Christmas jumper. The suggested donation is £1 with all proceeds going to the charity Save The Children. Additional fundraising ideas suggested within the pack included a hunt for each reindeer, whereby some of the adults in school wear a nametag with one of the reindeer's names on and children find them all. The School Councillors liked this idea so I said I would discuss this with Mrs Geldard and the teachers.
Fifth agenda: PTA Funding	Classes are continuing to suggest ideas for the PTA funding and Mrs Welsh suggested that we should vote on the most common ideas which the School Councillors thought would be a good idea. So far, the most requested ideas include: Football posts/nets, netball/basketball hoops and a sheltered area. The School Councillors also like Riley Barry's idea of using the PTA funding to purchase a type of storage for children's waterproofs.
